



US FUME: Fumigation Customer Preparation Checklist

1. All food (including food in the refrigerator/freezer) and medications must be removed from the structure or placed in **NYLOFUME BAGS** (ordinary plastic bags are not sufficient), this includes pet food as well. Only items factory sealed in jars or cans may remain.
2. All living things must be removed such as: plants, animals, fish, etc...
3. All gas appliances with pilot lights such as: water heaters, stove/oven, etc.... must be extinguished and the gas to the house shut off. The gas company in your area must turn the gas back on and relight the pilot lights.
4. All baby mattresses such as: crib, playpen, changing table, etc.. must be removed as well as any mattress with a plastic covering.
5. Although caution is used, we will need to work on the roof during fumigation. We will not be responsible for broken roof tiles, gutters, solar panels, etc... satellite dishes, flag poles and other roof protrusions must be lowered or removed. Antennas and satellites will need to be re aligned at property owner's expense.
6. State law requires that structures must be locked during fumigation and a key must be in the possession of the fumigator. Only our fumigator or a supervisor will enter the structure.
7. During the fumigation, we will not be responsible for vandalism, theft or breaking and entering. We will take every precaution state law allows to deter this from happening including but not limited to, a secondary locking system. However, we recommend that you take any extra measures that will give you peace of mind. Such as: Cameras and/or a motion sensor alarm which we offer for an additional charge. You may also choose to hire an on-sight watch person, a private security company, etc...
8. All awnings must be lowered. We will not be responsible for your awnings
9. Fences must have at least 6 inches of clearance from the buildings side walls. Please detach if applicable.
10. Any plants closer than 12-18 inches must be cut/ trimmed back. Mulch, rock or any bedding material must be raked away 12-18 inches from the base of the walls. Shrubbery, vines, trees and branches, if attached to the structure, must be removed in order for the tarps to fall freely around the structure. (branches and limbs over the roof must be removed) Note: Water shrubs and plants, that are located along the side of the structure, very heavily the night prior to the fumigation to help prevent browning.
11. Although we do recommend water heavily the night before, some shrubs and grass may brown up to 18 inches away from the structure due to soil exposure. There is no known remedy to prevent this occurrence.
12. Electricity and water usage must be made available to us during the fumigation to distribute and aerate the gas as well as to create a proper seal.
13. Pool and patio screens **MUST** be removed at the roofs edge. Also, side panels where tarps need to seal. Any screen doors under the fumigated area must also be secured with secondary locks and may require screens be removed as well.
14. We will need your driveway clear of all vehicles to allow access for our trucks.
15. Sprinkler systems must be turned off during fumigation.
16. We will open your attic hatches, so these must be accessible.
17. If cars are left in the garage, the windows and trunks must be left open.
18. Pool pumps located near the house must be turned off.
19. Cabinets and drawers should be left open a few inches to help with circulation and aeration.
